Fr. Tim was involved with CAYOCA from its early years. He loved spending time with the campers, saying Mass at the waterfront, and singing at campfire. Even after his illness didn't allow him to be at camp for a whole session, he came during the day to assist with reconciliation and be with the kids.

Because Fr. Tim thought that CAYOCA was important in the lives of young people, his family chose to donate funds in his memory so that kids with financial difficulties could attend this awesome camp.

Rev. Timothy was born in Boone on January 9, 1964. He grew up on a farm north of there and graduated from Boone High School in 1982. After graduating from Briar Cliff College, Sioux City, Iowa, he continued his education toward priesthood at Kenrick Glennon Seminary in St. Louis, Missouri.

Fr. Tim was ordained a priest in the Cathedral of the Epiphany in Sioux City in 1990. Progression of his illness, myotonic dystrophy, made it necessary for Father Tim Fitzgerald to move out of ministry as a parish priest. He served as chaplain at the Marian Home in Fort Dodge as well as ministered at the other nursing homes in the community. He went to be with the Lord on March 11, 2008.
